1. Welcome and Apologies

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies were as noted above.

2. Minutes of the previous meeting held on 24th October 2015.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were approved as an accurate record.

3. Police Report

Noted that due to the variation of shift patterns of the Community Officers, they have been unable to attend recent meetings of the Community Council.

Written report submitted to members prior to the meeting and officers presented the findings of the report. Noted that some traffic offences do not show up on the system and therefore Community Officers are unable to provide accurate numbers with regards to tickets issued for these offences.

Noted that there have been reports of bogus workmen and urged residents to alert Police if they suspect such activity.

A resident from Middlemuir Road in attendance at the meeting questioned the absence of incidents that take place in the street on the Police Report and previous reports. Resident advised of the steps she has taken and communication she has had with Stirling Council to resolve ongoing anti social and criminal behaviour in the street. The Chair advised that if there was anything the Community Council could do to assist then residents should make contact.

4. Planning Report

Alex Elliot noted the following: -

- 32 Kirkside Crescent – Change of Use of open space; and
- Planning application for Caledonian Market, Millhall.

5 Councillor's Report

Councillor corrie McChord noted that there has been approval granted by Westminster for funding for the City Deal.

Noted that following on from the Local Government Elections on 4th May 2017, there will be changes to the wards structure. The main change Stirling East will be that Riverside moves to the new Stirling North ward.

6 Afton Court Park Update

An application has been submitted for funding for the park to the CommunityPride Fund and a decision will be made on that in the next month.

Community Council noted that the play park should become a priority to the Community Council and regular contact with ward Councillors will be made with a view to improving the park.

7 Community Garden and Community Trust Update

Chair noted that there has been a lot of activity in the garden and there have been a number of successful events including some Open Days.

Noted that the weather station has arrived and should be up and running soon.

8 Correspondence

The Secretary noted the following correspondence: -

- The contract for the C48 bus route is due to expire and the Council are open to comments on this matter. Community Council noted that in order to keep the service it would be beneficial for a review of the times of the bus in line with the other bus routes that go through Braehead in order that busses are more frequent.

9 AOCB/Open Forum

The Chair proposed that the Community Council should consider filling the current vacancy via co-option at the next meeting. This was agreed unanimously and it was agreed that members would seek out willing volunteers with a view to a discussion and possible vote at the next meeting.
