- 84% members rated the garden as very good or excellent
- 80% rated it as good or excellent value for money

- Some least fav things: WEEDS!!, watering issues, lack of comms / info
- Ideas: groups on nature, growing, eco-friendly practices & cooking

UPDATE FROM TREELINK

Some of you may wonder what the fenced-off section of Braehead Community Garden is all about – what is Treelink Stirling and what do we do? We grow trees from seed, support community tree planting, help look after existing woodlands and encourage street tree planting. Our space at Braehead is the hub for many of our activities, and brings some of our volunteers together to plant, weed, lift and distribute young trees. <u>https://www.treelinkstirling.org/</u>

We work with partners including Vivisol Homecare, Cornton Nursery School, Equi-Power, Stirling Council and others to spread the word about trees and how

important they are. One of our successful projects is Free Trees for Babies which is sponsored by Vivisol. Last year we gave out 100 young trees to young families, and registrations are open for the coming winter planting season.

We are also working to create a bigger team of tree growers (our dispersed nurseries) all over the Stirling Council area who are building up stocks of seedlings in gardens or allotments for planting in our local communities over the next few years. We have some big projects in mind which will need lots of trees!
